Year C (Psalter Week 4)

Welcome to St Patrick's Church. Today's Gospel reminds us to always give thanks to the Father for His constant goodness to us. Through the Death and Resurrection of Jesus Christ, we have received new life in it's fulness. St Paul reminds us, in his letter to Timothy, that if we die in Jesus, we shall also live with Jesus. We who have been kept apart like lepers, through our own sins, are now made new through Jesus' saving power—the power of the Holy Spirit which cleanses and heals.
