A Walk for St Mary's - The Camino Way

For centuries, pilgrims have walked the Camino de Santiago, or the Way of Saint James. The ancient pilgrimage is a series of routes tracing their way across Europe and converging at the Cathedral of Santiago de Compostela in Galicia, Spain. This site is said to be the resting place of St James the Apostle.

Many undertake this pilgrimage as a time for reflection, gratitude, and renewal of faith. Inspired by the Jubilee 2025 theme: *Pilgrims of Hope*, Clarinda Mansfield, our parish administrator, along with seven friends, will walk the final 100 kilometres of the Camino Francés, one of the most travelled routes of the Camino de Santiago. The group intend to complete the journey over six days, walking roughly half a marathon each day.

As part of this pilgrimage, Clarinda is inviting everyone to sponsor her pilgrimage in support of St Mary's Church, Gosport. All expenses have already been covered, so all donations will go directly to support the parish. In gratitude, Clarinda will carry the prayer intentions of those who donate, and offer prayers along the way for all supporters, whether or not a donation is made.
