# Sunday 5 October 2025 : 27th Sunday of the Year

This Sunday's Gospel reading (Luke 17:5-10) needs to be read with an eye to Jesus' sense of humour. He starts a parable in answer to his disciples' request for an increase of faith with the words "Will any of you who has a servant ploughing or keeping sheep...", but he is talking to the poor: disciples who never had any servants, fields or sheep, and who left the little they had to follow Him. It's a joke, as is the story itself, if we remember back a few weeks to Luke 12:35-40, where Jesus told a parable about a master who was so pleased with his servants' vigilance that he did indeed serve them a meal! What is more, we have the image of the mustard seed to stand for our faith, which elsewhere stands for surprising and exponential growth: Luke 13:18-19. Jesus, who sometimes affectionately calls his disciples "ye of little faith", tells them not to fret about how much faith they feel they have: a little goes a long way, and they have all they need for now.
